The Spartanburg County Detention Facility tries to keep the most requested religious materials available for sale to the inmates in the jail's canteen/commissary at actual cost. There is no mark-up on any of the above items other than the purchase price of the printed materials plus shipping and handling costs as charged to the jail. If none of the above items actually meets the spiritual needs or tenets of an inmate's particular religious beliefs to whom you wish to send printed religious materials, then any materials sent to an inmate must come directly from the publisher of such materials and must have a soft back cover or binding. If you cannot find a publisher who will sell and ship the item for you, you can contact the jail directly, and we will make every effort to locate and provide the religious item for you at cost provided such item or items does not pose a risk to the safety and security of the facility. As with any item, the jail reserves the right to restrict and control access to the same as may be deemed necessary and appropriate to help maintain the safety and security of the jail, its staff, the inmates, and the public at large based on the facts and circumstances at the time of the request. The jail will not accept items or printed materials addressed to or delivered to an individual inmate from family members, friends, local book stores, or other persons other than directly from the publisher. Organizations, religious groups, and others may donate printed materials for the use of all inmates so detained within the jail after they have been screened for safety and security concerns by the jail's staff. Items so donated cannot be designated for the use of any particular inmate or individual and may be checked out of the jail's library on a first come and first serve basis in accordance with the jail's rules. Items with personal notes or messages will not be accepted for use in the library.
