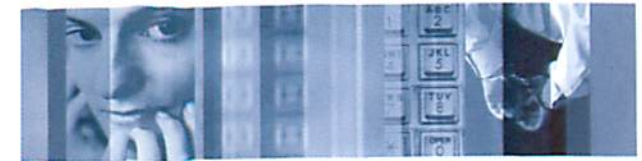

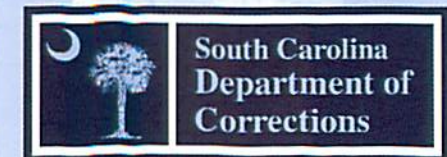

SAVIN FACTS

The SC SAVIN service is powered by VINE®

What will SC SAVIN do for me?



The SAVIN service will allow you to confirm that an offender is in jail and provide you with important custody status information. The service will also allow you to register to receive notifications automatically by phone and e-mail when there is a specific change in the custody status of an offender.

What do I need to do?

1. Determine whether or not the offender is in custody. Call 1-866-SC SAVIN (1-866-727-2846) from a touch-tone phone and follow the instructions or go to www.vinelink.com and follow the prompts.
2. Register for automated notification. If the offender is IN custody, you can register by contacting your local law enforcement victim advocate, calling 1-866-SC SAVIN (1-866-727-2846) from a touch-tone phone and speaking with a VINE operator, or going to www.vinelink.com and following the prompts. Provide the phone number(s) and email address where you would like notifications to be made.
3. Record your four-digit Personal Identification Number (PIN) code. Write the code on the back of this brochure or another safe place that you will remember. You will be asked to enter this PIN code when you receive an automated call from the SAVIN service.
4. Confirm that you received a notification. When you receive the automated call from the SAVIN service, listen to the message, then enter your PIN code when asked. Entering the PIN code confirms that YOU got the call, and will stop the service from calling again.

Victim Information & Notification Everyday

- The offender will not know you are registered with SAVIN.
- If you are unavailable, SAVIN will leave a message on an answering machine or voicemail and call again in 30 minutes. If there is no answer, the service will keep calling back until you enter your PIN or until 48 hours have passed.



- Since SAVIN calls automatically when an offender's custody status changes, you MAY get a call in the middle of the night.
- Do not register a phone number with SAVIN that rings to a switchboard or is connected to a pager service.
- You can register more than one phone number with the SAVIN service.
- You can register an e-mail address in addition to a phone number.
- **Remember SAVIN is only part of your safety plan. Do not depend solely on this service or any other single program for your protection.**
